- I. Danelle Smit opened with devotions at 6:30 on a “Recipe for Joy”.
- II. Matt Syens presented the Treasurer’s Report. Current balance is \$42,761.04. There are \$4,382 in team accounts, and \$14,000 in designated funds.. Concessions were very profitable this year, with profits currently showing close to \$15,000, with some potential outstanding bills.
 - A. Danelle Smit will meet with Stacey Braskamp to make sure all of her reimbursements have been turned in. For auditing purposes a credit card is not feasible.
- III. Old Business
 - A. Crusader Cards – Bethany Wellach is handling card collection and disbursement. Remaining funds will be distributed back to the Booster Club in June, prior to the end of the fiscal year.
 - B. Best Seat in the House - made about \$30 per night. Discussed some ideas for what could be done to raise funds on a nightly basis. Other schools have done bean bag and ducky tosses. Will discuss more next fall.
