



2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Applications are due no later than **March 31, 2024**. Applications submitted through USPS must be postmarked no later than this date. With the completed application, please submit a high school transcript and personal resume. If attending post secondary schooling, please also submit an unofficial transcript of credits taken.

In order to be eligible for the Leystra Seeds scholarship:

- Must be a son or daughter of a current Leystra Seeds customer or reside in one of the following WI counties: Columbia, Dodge, Green Lake, Marquette, Fond du Lac, Dane or Jefferson.
- Graduate from high school in the spring of 2024 and plan to attend furthering education of some sort, with a preference given to those furthering education in an agricultural or trade related field.
- Have graduated high school in the spring of 2023, currently enrolled in furthering education, with the intention to pursue a second year of schooling.
- Scholarship recipients must provide evidence of completion of first semester in the fall of 2024 to receive payment.
