The Joan M. Vande Castle Scholarship Fund was developed in 2016 to honor the Home Builders Association of Fond du Lac & Dodge Counties Executive Officer of 30 years, Joan M. Vande Castle. Joan made it her passion and dedicated her life to growing our Association. She and her husband, John (deceased), offered their home as the office and boardroom bringing those in the industry together for many years. Later, Joan led the members in the construction of the Rolling Meadows Drive building. Joan received numerous awards during her tenure, as she led a nationwide and statewide Executive Officer's Council. Joan was instrumental in the growth of the Home Builders Association. The Joan M. Vande Castle Scholarship was created to honor her for all her efforts and achievements as our Executive Officer.

The **Joan M. Vande Castle Scholarship** is available to students who will have completed high school and are enrolled in a formal program of higher education for the 2024-2025 academic year. Please note, students who are already enrolled in a formal higher education program may also apply.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- <u>1 \$300 scholarship</u> will be awarded to a qualifying student who is the **son/daughter** of a current Eastern Ridge Home Builders Association member business or the child of an employee of a member business. A student applying under this status must be enrolled in a formal program of higher education but is not required to enter a trades-related field.
- <u>1 \$300 Scholarship</u> will be awarded to a qualifying high school student who is entering college (or currently attending college) for a field of study relative to the building and trades industry. This scholarship is available to students who have graduated from High Schools in Fond du Lac, Dodge, or Green Lake Counties. It will be awarded based on the information provided on their application and their intended participation in any one of the following fields relative to residential construction: Construction Management, Architecture, Building Trades, Engineering (with an emphasis on construction trades), Interior Design, or other related fields of study relative to residential construction.

Please note that each scholarship may be earned a maximum of twice per student. To apply, please complete the scholarship application and questions. Additionally, please include a copy of your most recent transcripts and a letter of recommendation. Please note that these applications do NOT require official transcripts.

All applications must be postmarked by Monday, April 1, 2024. Scholarships will be awarded during the month of May. Should you have any questions regarding the application process, please
