

- Applied for enrollment in a Construction Management program at an accredited two- or four-year college, technical school, or university located in Wisconsin.
 Confirmed acceptance required prior to final award.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete the Michels Corporation Scholarship Application Form.
- Upload a copy of your most-recent high school or GED transcripts.
- Answer the 4 essay questions on the application.
- Include one or more letters of recommendation.

- If selected as a recipient, the student will receive a \$5,000 one-time award. Up to 10 awards will be granted.
- Internship opportunities for the Summer of 2026 and Summer of 2027 will be offered to students receiving scholarships.
- Future year scholarships may be considered for those students that complete Michels internships and maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA.
