

WAUPUN LIONS' CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: To assist a student, who has graduated from high school, to pursue his/her Education in any four year college degree program or two year (Associate Degree) vocational/technical program.

Requirements:

1. The Waupun Lions Club shall offer a two (2) year or four (4) year renewable scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 per school year.
2. The applicant must live within the Waupun School District attendance area. The applicant must have attained a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better in high school.
3. Selection will be based on a completed application form and an official high school transcript of grades through the 7th semester.
4. If the recipient does not follow through with plans to attend post-secondary schooling, this scholarship will be awarded to an alternate applicant.
5. The recipient chosen will be advised of his/her scholarship at the academic awards program at their high school of attendance if at all possible.
6. The scholarship shall be renewed to a maximum of 2/4 years providing that:
 - a. The recipient is a full-time student at an accredited college or technical school.
 - b. Maintains a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
 - c. Provides written proof of the same to **Richard Steinbach** by July 1st of each year.
7. The scholarship payment will be made at the beginning of each semester.
